



1. Pitch hire: It is very difficult to get the pitch in Kathmandu unless we hire.
2. We need bus fare, in average 30 Rupees per person, every day to reach the football pitch, no matter where we hold the training venue.
3. Two sets of T-shirts and socks, 18 white T-shirts, 18 white Short Pants, 18 white shocks, 18 Red T-shirts, 18 Red short pants, 18 red socks.

4. Training kits are needed to coach the boys systematically.
5. Coach charge is provided so that he can coach the team well.
6. After the game is over each players is given 10000 Rupees as a gift and staying with the team for 3 month.
7. During training period all first aid items are needed, like pain killers, bandages and others.
8. After the game, water, juice and some pieces of fruits are provided to players.
9. Lodging should be provided to half the players who need room near by the training pitch and who can't return home after the training.
10. Break, Lunch and Dinner is provided to half the players for 90 days with 250 Rs per day for one players.

Accountability

A receipt is provided each time donation is received for their valuable contribution towards the Church Boys United. We will print the receipt when the game is over and distribute to each one who made their contribution. We will use all fund in the develop of football.

We want to partner with you for the development of football in Nepal. We would not be able to achieve our goal without your involvement. Please partner with us to glorify God through sport, encourage young players, and develop the football ministry and carrier of the players who could bring glory of God in the football ground.
